\* Peninsula Music Society has been presenting an annual bursary program since 1998 to assist local music students with their studies and careers.

\* Peninsula Music Society's Bursaries are open to primary and secondary students living in the Mornington Peninsula Shire, or Frankston City.

\* Applicants must be studying: Piano, Violin, Viola, Cello, Double Bass, Flute, Piccolo, Oboe, Clarinet, Bassoon, French Horn, Trumpet, Tuba or Trombone with a minimum standard of AMEB Grade 6 or equivalent.

\* All students must present two contrasting pieces of music, no longer than 10 minutes, **from different eras** and provide their own accompanist, if needed.

\* Auditions will be held on 8 September at the Peninsula Community Theatre, Mornington and applicants will be notified of their audition time.

\* Please provide an email address so we can confirm your audition time.

\* All entrants will be auditioned and interviewed by a panel of adjudicators who decide the winners. Members of the panel are all professional musicians and independent of Peninsula Music Society.

\* A non-refundable entry fee of \$25 applies for each application. Only **one** application allowed per student.

\* Bursary winners are expected to perform at the Bursary Winners' concert on Saturday 22nd September 2.30pm at Peninsula Community Theatre.

\* This free concert is a wonderful performance opportunity and a chance for the community to enjoy your talent.
